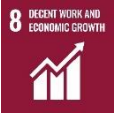


ATLAS ARTERIA (ALX) – FY2025 Communication on Progress Supplementary Document

Progress against priority Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by ALX businesses

ALX Priority SDG	Progress in 2025
#3 Good Health and Wellbeing 	Warnow Tunnel achieved the maximum 5 star iRAP certification in 2025: Warnow Tunnel iRAP, while Chicago Skyway obtained a 3 star iRAP certification: Chicago Skyway iRAP Report
#8 Decent Work and Economic Growth 	The Dulles Greenway is planning to be one of the first roads in Northern Virginia to implement PayNearMe which facilitates customer payment of tolls prior to receiving a violation notice through apps, ach, credit cards, and payment at retail outlets.
#9 Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure 	Following consideration of potential innovative material technologies in 2025, Dulles Greenway will be trialling the use of Elephant Armor as a more environmentally responsible concrete option in 2026. The use of Elephant Armor will be monitored on site to determine its performance over time. Even in greatly trafficked areas Elephant Armor claims to “greatly reduce the risk for spalling and delamination, eliminating the need for traditional remove and replace practices, helping to reduce the carbon footprint.” Elephant Armor contains a low embodied energy high cementitious formulation. This technology is expected to reduce carbon footprint, through resource conservation and reduced landfill waste. APRR continued the testing and monitoring of lower carbon asphalt alternatives during 2025.
#11 Sustainable Cities and Communities 	Dulles Greenway engaged with their waste contractor to obtain, for the first time, an estimate of waste volume on a monthly basis. The business will continue to engage with the waste contractor to encourage more accurate and detailed reporting of waste over time. Warnow Tunnel also engaged with their waste contractor (the City of Rostock) and after investigation it was found that there are no options available to estimate waste volumes at this time. During 2025 work was done (by a third party) to estimate the impact of Warnow Tunnel on air quality in downtown Rostock. It was found that had the approximately 4.77 million vehicles that used the Warnow Tunnel in 2025 been added to the traffic already passing through downtown, EU limits would have been exceeded.

ALX Priority SDG	Progress in 2025
#12 Responsible Consumption and Production 	A water meter was installed at Dulles Greenway during 2025 which enabled the recording of extracted water for the first time.
#13 Climate Action 	Warnow Tunnel continued to convert fleet vehicles to EVs and began replacing petrol equipment with electric to reduce GHG emissions in 2025. APRR reduced emissions in 2025 and introduced the use of HVO fuel to replace diesel, to significantly reducing emissions from those vehicles and continued to electrify their light vehicle fleet.
#15 Life on Land 	Existing projects continued to progress at APRR (eg Plant'Adapt, Ecograzing, Athenas Centre (Boreal Lynx protection) sponsorship). New projects were also introduced, for example using insects rather than herbicides to control the spread of Ragweed (an invasive exotic plant species) along the roadside.
